GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

1. Eligibility Criteria

All Students who are currently in Grade IX to Grade XII are eligible for participation at Udyam Model United Nations.

2. Powers of the Secreteriat

The Secreteriat of the confernce shall be vested to enforce the rules laid out in this handbook and any other direction as given by the school administraion.

3. Powers of the Bureau Members

The Presiding Officer will declare the opening and closing of each meeting and may propose the adoption of any procedural motion to which there is no significant objection. Subject to these rules, the executive board will have total control of the proceedings at any meeting. The Presiding Officer will direct discussions, accord the right to speak, put questions, announce decisions, rule on Points of Order, and ensure and enforce the observance of these rules. If necessary and given no objections, the Presiding Officer may choose to suspend the rules to clarify a certain substantive or procedural issue. The Presiding Officer may temporarily



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transfer his/her duties to another member of the Executive Board Panel or the Secretariat. The Executive Board may also advise delegations on the course of debate. In the exercise of these functions, the Executive Board will, at all times, be answerable to the Secretary-General. In case of a dispute, the decision of the Secretary-General shall be final and binding

4. Agression in Conference

No delegate shall, abuse or threaten in any manner any other delegate, bureau members and members of the Secretariat in any manner on any platform. any such delegate who shall be found guilty of the shall be reprimanded which can be temporary suspension, Ineligibility for awards or debarment from the conference and further sanctions as deemed necessary by the institution.

5. Electronic Device Policy

Use of any electronic devices during the conference session shall be prohibited. Delegates may carry their research in physical manner to refer any material. In case any delegate wishes to access internet may do so only during when committee is not in session.

5. Dress Policy



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All delegates must adhere to Western formal dress which present Professionalism and should be appropriate for a formal setting. The guidelines are as follows: Formal Business Attire: Delegates are encouraged to wear formal suits, blazers, formal shirts, trousers.

6. Appeal against Bureau members

A Delegate may appeal to any decision of the Presiding Officer, except for those matters for which the Committee Rules of Procedure explicitly prohibit. The Presiding Officer may speak briefly in defence of the ruling following which the appeal will be put to vote. The decision of the Presiding Officer will stand unless overruled by a two-thirds majority. The Presiding Officer has ultimate discretion on any ruling, whether it is appealed successfully or not until the Secretary-General intervenes

7. Plagiarism Policy

Plagiarism will not be tolerated at the conference. Any delegate found violating this policy while submitting any written work or delivering any verbal address will not be eligible to receive awards. Minor instances of plagiarism or limited AI-generated content in position papers, GSL speeches, or other submitted documents may lead to point deductions at the discretion of the Executive Board

7. Attendance Policy

For delegates to be eligible for participation certificates, all delegates must attend all sessions of the conference to be eligible for participation certificate.
